

From Research Idea to Funding Application: Getting Your Grant Proposal Together

These workshops are for researchers and health professionals who want to develop and submit an NIHR research funding application.

Preparing a good application takes time. This workshop will take you through the application process and help you plan and focus your ideas to produce a strong application. Thorough preparation will give you the best chance of getting your research idea funded.

Who are the workshops for?

This workshop is aimed at those who want to develop and submit a research funding application. You should have a reasonably clear idea of your research question and be prepared to discuss your idea with an RDS adviser ahead of the workshop (by phone at a pre-agreed time) if we need more information from you. This helps us to tailor our sessions for the day.

What will be covered on the day?

For those intending to develop and submit an application to NIHR, this workshop will highlight:

- An understanding of the practicalities of running a research study
- What funders are looking for in a submission
- Building a team of collaborators
- What to consider when costing a study
- The application process
