The Research Design Service Yorkshire and Humber (RDS YH) offers workshops to support health and social care researchers who are intending to apply for NIHR funding.

Who is the workshop for?

This workshop is for researchers and health professionals who want to develop and submit an NIHR research funding application. If you want to make a strong, competitive application which has the best chance of getting your research idea funded, then this event is for you.

Preparing a good application takes time. This workshop will illustrate the application process and will help you to focus your ideas and efforts to produce a strong application.

The workshop is **free to attend** and will run from 10.00 to 16.00. Lunch and refreshments will be provided. The day will include sessions on:

- Sources of funding and support for research
- The importance of a well-defined research question
- How to design a study to answer the research question effectively
- An understanding of the practicalities of running a research study
- What funders are looking for in a submission
- Building a team of collaborators
- What to consider when costing a study
- The application process

What do you need to do?

As this event is aimed at those wanting to develop and submit a research funding application we ask that:

- You have a clear idea of your research question
- You are prepared to discuss your idea with an RDS adviser ahead of the workshop (by phone at a pre-agreed time) if we need more information
- You are willing to undertake about 2 hours work ahead of the workshop
