

## From Research Idea to Funding Application: Getting Your Grant Proposal Together

28th June 2023, 10.00 - 13.30 (Online)

The Research Design Service Yorkshire and Humber (RDS YH) offers support to health and social care researchers who are intending to apply for [NIHR](#) and other national peer-reviewed health and social care research funding programmes. Preparing a good application takes time. This workshop will help you to focus your ideas to produce a strong application.

### Who is the workshop for?

This workshop is for researchers and health professionals who want to develop and submit a research funding application.

We ask that you have a research question or idea of your research topic and area. The workshop will provide an interactive environment to discuss your application to prepare for or continue with an RDS consultation after.

This is an online workshop and is **free to attend**. It will run from 10.00 to 13.30 and will aim to cover:

- The importance of a well-defined research question.
- Ensuring public involvement informs the development and delivery of the proposal
- Understanding the importance of planning for the research impact of the proposal.
- Designing a study to answer the research question effectively: Q&A on the practicalities and costing to make a good application.

### Pre-workshop preparation

In order to get the most out of the workshop, we will send participants some material to look through ahead of time. This will include a set of accessible slides on key topics, guidance about sources of funding and support for research. We will also ask you to start thinking about how to present your research idea in an accessible way by preparing a brief summary in plain English. Participants can use this summary to discuss with other attendees during the workshop. We estimate that this preparation should take about 2 hours of your time ahead of the workshop
